ORDINANCE No. 2 of 2009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER A251 "SENIOR CITIZENS ASSOCIATION BYLAWS" OF THE SOUTH FAYETTE TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY AMENDING SECTION A251-10. "MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS" AND SECTION A251-18 "ELIGIBILITY FOR OFFICE".

WHEREAS, the South Fayette Township board of Commissioners adopted through Ordinance No. 12 of 2005 a set of bylaws for the Senior Citizens Association Bylaws; and

WHEREAS, These bylaws may be amended by a majority vote of the membership of the Association present in person at a meeting when the vote shall be take; provided, however, that any proposed change to the bylaws shall have either been proposed by the Bylaws committee or submitted to the Bylaw Committee for its recommendation, and further provided that no vote on an amendment to the bylaws may be taken until the proposed change shall have been announced at two consecutive meetings of the Association; and

WHEREAS, the South Fayette Township Board of Commissioners desires to modify Chapter A251 of the Township code to reflect the desired changes of the South Fayette Area senior Citizen Advisory Board to the Association bylaws as detailed below

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Replace in its entirety Section A251-10. "Admission into membership" to read as follows:

Any person meeting the above requirements shall be eligible for membership at any time during the calendar year. Payment of dues is required at the time of

joining. Dues shall be five dollars 5.00 or (amount to be set by the board) annually and shall be payable prior to the March meeting of each year.

Section 2. Replace in its entirety Section A251-18. "Eligibility for office" to read as follows:

Any member who has been a member of the Association for a least three (3) months prior to the election and is in good standing with the Association, may serve as an Officer of the Association

Section 6. Severability and Conflicts


1. The proper officials of the Township of South Fayette are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance.
2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of the Ordinance are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeals shall only be to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other aspects, this Ordinance shall be cumulative with the other ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this Ordinance.
3. If any section or provision or parts thereof in this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any other section or provision or part thereof.

Section 7. Effective Date.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required.
