**ORDINANCE NO. 09 OF 2008**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 205 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP ENTITLED "SOLID WASTE", TO: AMEND SECTION 205-16 E BY ADDING LANGUAGE THAT LIMITS THE TIME A RESIDENT MAY PLACE REFUSE AND RECYCLING CONTAINERS AT CURBSIDE TO TWENTY-FOUR HOURS IN ADVANCE OF THE REGULAR COLLECTION TIME.**

**WHEREAS,** the Board of Commissioner of the Township of South Fayette on November 16, 1998, by Ordinance no. 409, adopted a codification of its Ordinances (hereinafter referred to as the "Township Code"); and

**WHEREAS,** the Board of Commissioners of the Township of South Fayette adopted rule and regulations regarding the collection and disposal of municipal waste and recycling; and

**WHEREAS,** The Township of South Fayette, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens, desires to modify the regulations that govern the placement of recycling and refuse containers by residents s at curbside; and

**WHEREAS,** The South Fayette Township Board of commissioners desires to modify Chapter 205 "Solid waste" of the Township Code by establishing rules and regulations limiting the placement of refuse and recycling containers at curbside to within twenty-four hours of the normal collection schedule.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONER OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section I. Amendments to Chapter 204 "Solid Waste"**

- A. Add to Article II, §E (8): Containers for both refuse and recycling shall not be placed at curbside to the designated collection point prior to twenty-four (24) hours in advance of the designated collection time.


**Section II. Seperability and Conflict**

- A. The proper officials of the Township of South Fayette are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance.
- B. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeals shall only be to extent of such inconsistencies and in all other aspects, this Ordinance shall be cumulative with the other ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this Ordinance.
- C. If any section or provision or parts thereof in this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any other section or provision or part thereof.
- D. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the and after its passage and publications as required.


**Section III. Effective Date**
