

**SOUTH FAYETTE TOWNSHIP
RESOLUTION 11 of 2018**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE ENTRY INTO A
MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE SOUTH HILLS
AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR POLICE
SERVICES THROUGHOUT THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF
MEMBER COMMUNITIES IN A CRITICAL EMERGENCY
EVENT**

WHEREAS, local government units are authorized pursuant to 53 Pa. C.S.A. § 2303 to enter into Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreements in the exercise and performance of the respective governmental functions, powers and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the providing of police protection, through Mutual Aid Agreements, with other governmental units serves to enhance the protection of residents of the Township of South Fayette; and

WHEREAS, the Township of South Fayette is a member of the South Hills Area Council of Governments (“SHACOG”); and

WHEREAS, the Township of South Fayette is a participant in a Critical Emergency Response Program – Police, established through the SHACOG; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the municipal participants in the Program to enter into an agreement to provide mutual police aid throughout the territorial limits of the respective SHACOG municipalities in the event of a critical emergency event.

NOW, THEREFORE, be resolved it is hereby resolved by the Commissioners of the Township of South Fayette as follows:

1. The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated herein by reference thereto.
2. The Township of South Fayette does hereby authorize the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners to enter into a Mutual Aid Agreement in the form and content attached hereto and made part hereof as Exhibit “A”, to provide for mutual Police Aid throughout the territorial limits of the respective SHACOG municipalities in the event of a critical emergency even
3. This Resolution is to take effect upon adoption;
4. Any Ordinance or Resolution, or portion thereof, conflicting with the provisions of this Resolution shall be and the same is hereby repealed, insofar as the same affects this Resolution.
