WHEREAS, on or about March 23, 2020 the President Commissioners of the Township of South Fayette issued a Declaration of Disaster Emergency within the of South Fayette due to the imminent threat to public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens Township of South Fayette; and


WHEREAS, the (disaster) threatens to create problems greater in scope than the Township of South Fayette, may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents in the Township of South Fayette,

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Board of Commissioners of the Township of South Fayette, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA CS), as amended, do hereby extend the Declaration of Disaster issued by the President of the Commissioners of Township of South Fayette until the President of the Commissioners of the Township of South Fayette issues a proclamation finding and declaring that the threat to public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Township of South Fayette has abated.


This Declaration shall take effect immediately, the 15 day of April 2020.
