RESOLUTION 5 of 2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH FAYETTE TOWNSHIP, ESTABLISHING THE PROGRAM CRITERIA FOR THE VOLUNTEER SERVICE CREDIT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the South Fayette Township has adopted South Fayette Township Ordinance No. 02-2018, establishing a Volunteer Service Credit Program in compliance with Act 172 of 2016, on January 15, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE it is resolved that the Program Criteria for the Volunteer Service Credit Program is established as follows:

1. A volunteer shall:
 - a. Respond to a minimum of 30% of all fire calls/training activities of the respective volunteer fire company; or
 - b. Participate in a minimum of 50% of the time attributed to approved activities such as administrative services, fundraising, bookkeeping, equipment maintenance, and emergency management; or
 - c. Respond to less than 30% of fire calls/training activities but also participate in a minimum of 50% of the time attributed to approved activities such as administrative services, fundraising, bookkeeping, equipment maintenance, and emergency management; and
2. A volunteer shall complete any and all required training associated with the position; and
3. The Volunteer Service Credit Program is available to residents of South Fayette Township who are volunteers of any of these fire companies: South Fayette (Cuddy) VFD, Fairview VFD, Oak Ridge VFD, or Sturgeon VFD; and
4. The eligibility period will be from January 1st until December 31st of each year; and
5. The Chief of each respective volunteer fire company shall keep specific records of each volunteer's activities in a service log. The Chief will present the notarized eligibility list to the Township Manager no later than January 31st of each year.
