RESOLUTION NO. 17 OF 2023

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE, ALLEGHENY  
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, RECOGNIZING STEEL CITY  
BLADES AS A CIVIC AND SERVICE ORGANIZATION FOR  
PURPOSES OF THE SMALL GAMES OF CHANCE ACT**

WHEREAS, Steel City Blades (the “Association”) is a non-profit corporation organized and existing in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Association has its principal business office in South Fayette Township; and

WHEREAS, the Association is interested in obtaining a Pennsylvania Small Games of Chance license to conduct events as may be permitted under the Pennsylvania Small Games of Chance Act (the “Act”); and

WHEREAS, it is believed that the Association intends to utilize the proceeds of such events to further their civic mission; and

WHEREAS, the Act allows for certain “eligible organizations” to be licensed; and

WHEREAS, the Act defines an “Eligible Organization” as “A charitable, religious, fraternal or veterans’ organization, club, club licensee or civic and service association. In order to qualify as an eligible organization for purposes of this act, an organization shall have been in existence and fulfilling its purposes for one year prior to the date of application for a license. The term shall include an affiliated nonprofit organization licensed under section 307”. 10 P.S. § 328.103 (emphasis added); and

WHEREAS, the Act further defines “Civic and Service Association” as “ Any Statewide or branch, lodge or chapter of a nonprofit national or State organization which is authorized by its written constitution, charter, articles of incorporation or bylaws to engage in a civic or service purpose within this Commonwealth, which shall have existed in this Commonwealth for one year. *The term also means a similar local nonprofit organization, not affiliation with a national or State organization, which is recognized by a resolution adopted by the governing body of the municipality in which the organization conducts its principal activities...*” 10 P.S. § 328.103 (emphasis added);

WHEREAS, the Association is believed to be “a local nonprofit organization not affiliated with national or State organization”; and

WHEREAS, the Association is believed to have been in existence since 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Association has requested that South Fayette Township recognize it as a “Civic and Service Association” for purposes of the Small Games of Chance Act; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissions of the Township of South Fayette is satisfied that the Association is a Civic and Service Association for purposes of the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of South Fayette recognizes Steel City Blades as a “Civic and Service Association” for purposes of the Small Games of Chance Act.
