ORDINANCE NO. 4 OF 2024

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE,
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING
CHAPTER 227, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE III,
SECTION 227-7, EXHIBIT A OF THE SOUTH FAYETTE CODE
OF ORDINANCES TO AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
A STOP INTERSECTION, AT THE INTERSECTION OF ALPINE
ROAD AND HICKORY HEIGHTS DRIVE, AND AT THE
INTERSECTION OF OLD OAKDALE ROAD AND
MIDDLEFIELD DRIVE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of South Fayette has studied traffic conditions at or near the intersections of Alpine Road and Hickory Heights Drive, and at or near the intersections of Old Oakdale Road and Middlefield Drive; and

WHEREAS, the installation of stop signs, at such locations, are necessary and appropriate as a speed calming and safety device; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of South Fayette, in lawful session duly assembled, as follows:

1. Chapter 227, Vehicles and Traffic, Article III, Section 227-7, Exhibit A, Stop Intersections are hereby amended to permit the installation of stop signs, at the following location:

<u>Stop Sign on</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>	<u>At Intersection of</u>
Alpine Road	Northwest	Alpine Road & Hickory Heights Drive
Old Oakdale Road	North	Old Oakdale Road & Middlefield Drive
Old Oakdale Road	South	Old Oakdale Road & Middlefield Drive

2. The proper officials of the Township of South Fayette are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to effectuate the purpose of this ordinance.


3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeals shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other aspects, this ordinance shall be cumulative of the other ordinance regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this ordinance.

4. If any section or provision or parts hereof in this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any other section or provision or part thereof.

5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
